# PERSONAL INTERESTS

I am interested in topics that straddle the fields of history and political science. During my studies, I mostly focused on the origins and development of political order, particularly in the context of Western Europe. This includes the process towards the formation of the modern state and the establishment of representative forms of government, but especially more recent phenomena like secularization, sociocultural liberalization, new social movements and European integration. The overarching aim that I pursued was to get a better understanding of how today's intricate systems of governance in European societies emerged and how they successfully managed to adapt to the profound changes that occurred particularly during the course of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. My master's thesis in political science (supervised by Prof. Kris Deschouwer) reflects this as it combined my interest in recent socio-cultural changes, in this case the quest for the legal affirmation of women's reproductive rights, with the rather atypical

organization of democracy in the profoundly divided societies of Belgium and the Netherlands, where social progress on thorny ethical questions threatened to destabilize a delicate system of democratic governance. Today I am also interested in the origins of right-wing populist challenges to liberal democracy in Western Europe.
