Additional information

I've been member of the Environmental Sustainability Commission of the University of Turin. This body's mission was to improve the environmental sustainability of the university itself reducing its ecological impact. The first tasks of the Commission have been to elaborate and coordinate a research project aimed at getting a preliminar analysis of the university's environmental impact and to elaborate some practical proposals for future developments.

During the academic year 2005/2006 I've participated to the Erasmus mobility programme. I've lived in Brussels for 10 months, getting the enriching experience of living in a strategic location, characterized by an intense and active international environment. This experience allowed me to improve my knowledge of french and to attend the courses of a prestigious academic institution as the Université Libre de Bruxelles, among others.

Afterwards, I've spent two months in Senegal (February-Mars 2007) in a field research period. This was aimed at getting data and information related to my thesis' topic: the senegalese emigration and its impact on the country's development. In particular I have analysed some projects realised by migrants' organization in collaboration with senegalese and italian local authorities. This experience was of crucial importance not only for my personal growth but, also for my professional training. On one side I have faced a very difficult context, but on the other side I have experienced all the difficulties of a field research work. During this period I have realised some interviews with returnees or migrants' relatives, with public officers and academic researchers, I have collected data, reports and documents.
