General Description: The school provides an advanced intensive training course for research students, scholars and professionals who are working in the area of the economics and policy of competition and market regulation. It combines training in:

- i) the institutional and legal features of competition policy in the EU compared to other regions;
- ii) the economic and theoretical underpinnings of market regulations;
- iii) the analysis of case studies.

The lecturers are leading international academics and professionals with outstanding experience in the field.

Participants: The school is open to 30 students from all countries. Students are expected to attend the school full time.

Applications and deadlines: The participants will be selected by the Selection Committee on the basis of the information included in the application forms. The applications should be submitted by e-mail to the Secretarial Office Graduate School (e-mail:graduate.school@unimi.it). The deadline for submission is <u>May</u> <u>31, 2007</u>.
